goods, chattels and personal estate of Juliana S.

late of Queen Anne's county, deceased, according to law, and shall in all respects discharge the duties of ~~her~~ required
by law as *Administrator, &c.* aforesaid, without any injury or damage to any person interested in the faithful perfor-
mance of said office, then the above obligation shall be void, otherwise it is to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
