Be it remembered that on the twenty ninth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty the following Deed of Manumission was brought to be recorded to wit: We all whom it may concern be it known that I Julianna S. Godwin of Queen Anne's County in the State of Maryland for diverse good causes and considerations me therein moving have released from Slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my negroman named Ben Hyson when he shall arrive at the age of thirty eight years, which will be in January Eighteen hundred and sixty nine, My woman named Kelly Goldsborough when she arrives at the age of thirty five years, which will be in November Eighteen hundred and eighty one, My negroman Elizabeth Goldsborough when she arrives at the age of thirty five years which will be in November Eighteen hundred and eighty three, My neg girl May C. thirty to be free when she shall arrive at the age of thirty five, which will be in May Eighteen hundred and seventy four, My neg boy George Goldsborough when he shall arrive at the age of thirty eight years which will be in April Eighteen hundred and ninety one, and my neg boy Charles Peirby to be free when he shall arrive at thirty eight years of age, which will be in February Eighteen hundred and ninety seven, and then the said or above named negroes, I do declare to be free at the periods above named manumitted and discharged from all manner of service to me my Executors or Administrators forever thereafter. Know all men by these presents, that I Benjamin Lippage of Queen Anne's County, Maryland in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars, for which I am indebted to William H. Porter of the same County as security on my negotiable note to the Farmers and Mechanics Bank of Kent County, and likewise other Indebtedness. Now therefore in consideration thereof I do hereby bargain and sell to the said William H. Porter the following property to wit, my beloved boy Charles, who is about thirteen years old, and also my colored boy Lewis, who is about ten years old, both of whom are entitled to be free at the age of twenty eight years respectively. Provided nevertheless, that should I the said Benjamin Lippage, my executors or administrators, well and truly pay the aforesaid William H. Porter the above noted debt and pay or cause to be paid the above recited note, and prevent his suffering any loss or damage, as my security therein, then these presents shall be void.
