hundred and Ninety the following (Deed was brought to be Recorded to wit)

This Agreement made this twenty second Day of April in the year of our Lord seventeen  
hundred and Ninety William Wright of Queen Anne County in the province of  
Maryland Doctor and Mary his wife one of the Daughters of Joseph East late of Queen  
Anne County Deceased of the one part and William Emery of the same County and  
Province of the other part witnesseth that the said William Wright and Mary his  
Wife for and in Consideration of the sum of Sixty six Pounds Current Money to them in  
hand paid by the said William William Emery about before the sealing and Delivery of these  
Presents the Receipt whereof the said William Wright acknowledged and then and  
of every part thereof doth acquit and Discharge the said William William Emery his  
Executors and Administrators from all Laws Given Granted Bargained and sold above  
Expressed and Confirmed and by these Presents Do Give Grant Bargain and sell above  
Expressed and Confirm unto the said William William Emery his Heirs and Aforegoes for  
ever all those parts and parcels of the Town of Land called Emery's Fortune assi-  
tance and Partnership which are contained within and Described by the dimensions herein  
describ following to wit Beginning at the End of Two Hundred and Eighty five perches  
on the South East line of a tract of Land called Mandersfield granted unto  
a certain Michael Parker Mandersfield for three hundred and fifty acres containing  
threes North thirty six Degrees East on hundred and eighty five perches to a  
tract of land called the Fortune hope with that land West North West three  
perches then North North East eighty five perches then North thirty six Degrees
