

Bomberger to Be Hung.

The statement sent out from Cando, North Dakoto, last week, that the severest punishment that could be inflicted on Bomberger, the murderer of six members of the Kreider family, would be imprisonment for life, was not correct. There were nine indictments against the murderer, to all of which he plead guilty: Six charges of murder, one for the man's slaughter of an unborn child, another for rape and the ninth for larceny. The judge in pronouncing sentence said: "The crime was an atrocious one. The annals of crime reveal none worse. The court discovers no reason for clemency, and sentences you to be hanged by the neck until you are dead. May God have mercy on your soul." Pursuant to the law of that State, that the execution must take place within 60 days from the day of sentence, the time of the hanging is fixed for the 19th of January, '94.
