Cando, N.D., Nov 22 1893

Dear Parents. I will now write to you to let you know how my trial went on here at Cando. I will also tell you that I have seen Sam & Dave last night after the trial I have seen them often they <sup>were</sup> ~~were~~ alone & I have told them all & anything that I do not think of at present. Your will let you know for he had some trouble with Dan Krieger similar to mine now I will explain it to you all I came here last winter & as soon as I came of the train the first man I met was Dan Krieger & he suggested to me that I should work for him but I did not go with him then for I did not like him I worked here in the town for about two weeks when I was taken sick & Dan was after me again & left \* after me until I made a bargain with him he was to pay me \$300 for one years work & I accepted it & went with him to the farm well it was a cold winter & I had to work every day cold or not & I knew how ill he was but I made a bargain & told him that if I was to work for him he would have to take care of the team that he drove & that I would take care

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of the ones that I would drive so I took care of all the horses all winter & done all the work that was to be done on the place I used to cut all the wood & when they wanted any wood they would tell me to go after it, Dan would not take a stick if it was laying right by the door nor none of the rest of the family, but this not bothered me so much until in the spring when the farm work started then I used to go out to work & when I came home & got done with my chores & wanted to go to bed I would have to make my own bed & I had to do this all winter but it did not bother me in the winter but so when I had to work all day on the farm then I ask Annie who makes the beds & she told me she did them I told her that she should make my bed as I had to work hard & needed to have a good bed to rest in but she did not seem to care so I told Mrs Knudsen about it but it was not any better & that used to make me awful mad the harder I would work the more I would think of it & the madder I would get & I felt like quitting him but then if I would think if I quit I would not get anything for my

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for my winter's work & I did not want to loose that  
for I worked for it so when we started to do our  
herding in the spring I used to go out in the morning  
& curse of all the horses & put on the harness on all  
of them before breakfast & then when Dan would go to  
town he would kick on the horses mane the mane  
would not stay on one side as good many horses mane  
will part & some of it go to each side then he would  
kick & say I did not curse the horses but I did not  
say anything I left it go on but was sick at heart of  
the job but made up my mind to stick out the year  
so after we were working awhile in the spring Dan  
would turn his teams loose when he came in the  
yard & I would have to go & take off the bridles of  
his horses & change & pump water for all of them  
before dinner then after dinner he would send me  
out to oil his drill & clean out all the shovels & fix  
everything that was to be done the same way when  
we went to plowing I would have to grease his  
plow for him & sharpen his plow tays & tighten  
all the bolts on it & then when he would go to  
town & come home he would kick & want to know

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what I was doing all day he would say that I did not do anything & what I did do would not suit him everything ~~that~~ I done would not be right he would say why did you not do so & so & that would make me feel awful bad I was sick of it all the while I was there but try & stick out the year, I used to put in a lot of straw for bedding & then they would turn in the hogs & cattle & they would spoil all the bedding & they would say I did not put in clean straw & when Anna would milk the cows she would say Abbott put some straw here then I would put it there & still I could not satisfy her she would kick one day I was to put some colts in the pasture & one of them would not follow its mother and I throwed a rope around its neck that I had in my hand & was pulling it along when Mrs. Reid come out & scolded me & said I would pull the neck of it then she told Dan & he blowed me about it then one time Dan went to town & he told me to bring in a load of wheat & the team he told me to take was a poor team so when I started one of the horses would not pull

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& I tried to pay up the load & git them started when Mrs. Knicker came out & scolded me for hitting the horses when I told her to mind her own business & never mind me for I was driving that team I was so mad at the time that I could not help it I used to be so mad that I could not sit up with them in the house as soon as I would git done with my chores I would go up to my room & go to bed & many a night I would lay in bed all night awake & think of how I was abused but always had in my mind to stay my year so after sowing & spring work I had to put up a pasture & I would dig post holes all day & work hard & at night Dan would kick & say that I did not do anything I told him that I was doing all that I possibly could do but he was not satisfied another time when I was sowing a slough that was full of water in the spring & I had to sow it by hand & harrow it I was quite away from the house they could not see me from the house & in the evening when Dan come in the girls just got home from school with the pony then Dan took the pony & come down

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on a dead dead run to where I was & says to me what  
are you doing here all day you should have been done  
with this here long ago than that made mad to think  
that I was working hard all day & then have him to  
come & jump on to me that way so I told him that  
he would have to quit that & that I had enough  
of his wifes bossing, so I had to haul manure  
from the place & they would kick & say that I was  
not cleaning it up good enough but still I did not  
say anything I wanted to work my place & then as  
much as I have been around the country I never  
thought of playing poker or gambling but when  
I was with Dan he took me into the gambling  
houses & kept urging me on to play poker  
untill at last I sat in & played & then when I  
used to win Dan would get mad at me & another  
time I bought a box of cigars & left them up in my  
room when the children took & broke them up & Dan  
asked me to bring the box down & show it to him  
& so I did & all he done about it was to laugh I was  
so sick of it that I used to go to town & did not  
care what I done with my money I used to git

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down just a purpose to putt it of my mind then  
the morning that this trouble happened me I never  
thought of killing any of them I got up & went to  
the pasture & caught a horse & while I was  
currying it my brain started to work & I was dizzy  
& thought that my head would split so all of a  
sudden a thought struck my mind while I felt  
like this that it would be best to get rid of the  
whole family so I went in & killed them & while  
I was going in I remember that I was so mad  
that the forth just foamed out of my mouth  
& then after I shot those that I killed I began to  
realize what I was doing & quit & I could not kill  
anymore so you see how it all is now there is  
a good deal that I left out of him a I cannot think  
of it all as I write but I will write to you again  
later on & I can tell you a good deal more as  
he had trouble with them similar to mine I  
was brought here for trial & pled guilty the people  
here use me well I will receive my sentence on Thursday  
after which I will write to you as you see what drove me  
to it do not trouble yourself on my account

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when Annie used to be in the barn I would fool with her when we were good friends & would bump her around when I carried in hay & have often tried to do it to her & said I would get it in & to her yet one night I went to her room & she would not have it so I went back to my room & once I went into Bronies room & put my hand under the cover when she gave a start & I went to my room & did not bother her anymore when we used to play cards together in the house at night Dan would always get mad & say that I cheated & was trying to draw his girls to cheat at another time I had one horse tethered up to bridle manner when Bronie come & took it to haul some water & she did not bring the horse back & I run after her when Dan come out & said dont you go for any of my children or I will show you Annie used to be around me & I would get worked up & would feel like laying her right down & put it to her the night before I murdered them we were playing croquet & never thought of harming them that night I went to Annes room & told

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to get it from her but she would have it so I went to bed & lay awake all that night thinking of her she said she was going to tell the old folks about it so when I done the deed in the morning I shot Dan first & did not know whether he was asleep or not I next shot the Mrs in the kitchen she never said a word I then got some more shells up over the pump house & went to the stairs & told Annie that she should go to my room they were all standing at the head of the stairs all but the little ones then I went up & shot into them I then seen Mrs by jump out of the window & I went & brought her back & shot her then I could not kill anymore I then went to Annie in my room & she begged me to save her life & I told her she need not be scared I could not kill anymore I then put it to her on my bed I then told her to get me something to eat & she got me a pie & some bacon but I could not eat it I put two pieces of pie & some bacon in my pocket then told her to get the money she had in her room then told her to get the watch then we went to the stable & I took the rifle with me I then had Annie to git me the

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ridiculous brother than I had her walking up & down  
the stable & she begged of me again the cold sweat was  
running of me she said if I spared her & she would  
let me do it again & she went in to a stall & I did  
it again I was then going to tie her up but says to  
her she better go upstairs the hogs might eat her down  
here so she went upstairs & I tied her I then went  
& saddled the pony & started I left the office it was  
so heavy I did not try to get away or they would  
have caught me Dan was always mean to his  
children Annie is a bastard she was born of Mrs &  
Mr Krieger before they were married Dan was no  
good anyway when he got a little bit the bit of a  
man he would shit on him it is all over now  
& I will not try to get away but will stand to it  
as I know & what I done I know what I am going  
to get but I will take two but I do wish that  
I would have quit in June when I was going to & I  
would not be here to day.
